

Papulopustular rosacea, or PPR for short, is a type of rosacea marked by persistent facial redness and acne-like bumps or pimples. We are currently conducting a clinical research study of an investigational foam medication for those that suffer from papulopustular rosacea.

**To qualify, you must be:**

- **18 years of age or older**
- **Have moderate to severe papulopustular rosacea**
- **Have a minimum of 15 papules or pustules on your face (acne-like red bumps)**

There is no cost to enroll in the trial. Participants who qualify will receive study-related evaluations and medication at no cost. Insurance is not required to participate and compensation for travel and time may be provided.

In addition to any relief you may receive from the study medication you are assigned to use throughout this research study, your participation may also help to answer important questions regarding the safety and effectiveness of the investigational medication. This could provide new information about the treatment for papulopustular rosacea, which may help other patients in the future.
